This indenture made this 9th day of February 1820 between Abner
Center of state of south Carolina and Greenville district of the
one part and John Evans Junr of the state and district aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth that for an inconsideration of the
sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said
John Evans the receipts whereof is hereby fully acknowledged
both bargain sold and delivered and by these presents doth
bargain sell and deliver unto the said John Evans his heirs and
assigns for ever a certain tract a parcel of land situated lying
and being on the head of middle tyger river it being part of
a tract of land surveyed for John Blanton 2^d day of September 1784
having such bounds as follows beginning on a white oak in the
fork of the branch and running thence N. 35 W. 38 & 50 to
cross a creek thence N. 88 E 15 to a maple on the bank of the creek
thence S. 80 E to white oak Conditional corner thence along
Conditional line to a hickory corner near the old school house spring
thence S. 78 W 17 to a willow on the bank of the creek thence
S. 12 W 7 to a persimmon thence S. 20 W 10 to a persimmon thence S. 55 W.
15 to a white oak thence N. 87 W. 5: 50 to the beginning corner
suppose to contain one hundred and fifty acres more or less toge-
ther with all and singular the rights and premises to the same
belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all & singular
the said premises to the proposee and behalf of him the said John
Evans his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend
from myself my heirs and assigns and any other person or persons law-
fully claiming the same or any part thereof in witness whereof
I said Abner Center hath hereunto set my hand and seal
this day first above written sign seal & deliver in presents of us
