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The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I
Harmon Pitt of the district of Greenville and state aforesaid have for
and in consideration of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid
granted bargained sold & released unto Wm Cox of the district
and state aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being on the water of Lendman's branch of muddy river
in Greenville district the same containing one hundred and
thirty six acres and being and lying in manner & form as
follows, that is, Beginning on a stake running S 46° 02' E
58 Chs to a stake then S 52 E 40 to a Spanish oak thence N 16 E
49 to a stake thence N 75 W 40 to a red oak thence 4 chs to a
stump in the road thence f 43 E 15 to the beginning corner the same
as above mentioned including one hundred & thirty six acres
to it more or less being part of a tract of land granted to
John Lafferty. Together with all and singular the buildings
and improvements and appurtenances therunto belonging or in
