in the District of Greenville aforesaid in wild cat creek a branch of south
Tyger river beginning at a Chestnut a corner made for Robert Carter thence
S. 14 deg to a chestnut thence N 75 E to the creek thence up with
the meanders of the creek to Carters line & thence S. 62 W. with Carters line
to the beginning containing by estimation thirty four acres be the
same more or less the same being the S. W. of survey granted unto
James Gray by partition bearing date 18th January 1790 for two hundred
and fifty acres also another parcel of land joining lands of the above
survey sold to Robert Carter beginning at a fist oak Carters corner
thence nearly a N. E. cost to a red oak a baronial corner near the
Burcum road thence with Solomon Dill line to a Spanish oak near
the mill pond and then with Dills line to Carters line to a stake &
thence to the beginning supposed to contain ten acres the same being
a part of a survey granted to Samuel Shaw & known by hole tract
together with all & singular the rights numbers hereditaments &
