State South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Gaultney of Greenville district for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Edward Dill of the district aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release a tract or plantation of land lying and being in district aforesaid on the side of wild cat branch the waters of Fatenburgs beaverdamcreek beginning at a light wood stake in land now owned by M. Steward and running S. 45 W. 67 ch. 50 links to a chestnut thence S. 58 E. 10 chs to a Black oak thence N. 21 E. 18 chs to a pigeonon on the side of wild cat branch thence down the several meanders of the same to a dogwood thence S. 60 E. 19 chs to a black oak thence N. 26 E. 43 chs to the beginning containing by estimation two hundred & nineteen acres be the same or less including the plantation & whereon I now live being part of a tract of land originally granted unto Austin Clayton the first day of July 1793 reference being had to the several surveys as heretofore made thereunto will make this title fully appear together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances thereunto belonging or in way appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> Edward Dill his heirs & assigns for ever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & Executors to warrant & defend the above mentioned premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Edward Dill his heirs & assigns against me & my heirs & against every person or persons who may lawfully claiming a title claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereto set my hand & seal this twenty eighth day of Feb. in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty one 44<sup>th</sup> year of the american independance signed sealed & delivered in presence.
