In plain and open market deliver unto the said Thomas Hamilton
Four Negroes, that is to say, Rose, Sypse, John and Fanny to have &
To hold the said Slaves with the future offspring of and
increase of the said Rose and Fanny unto the said Thomas Ham-
ilton his heirs Executors administrators and assigns & that
I Charles Toney for myself my heirs Executors and administrators
do covenant promise and agree to and with the said Thomas
Hamilton that I will warrant and defend the said slaves
Named Rose, Sypse, John & Fanny and their future increase unto
the said Thomas Hamilton his heirs Executors assigns and assigns
from and against every other person whomsoever in witness where-
upon I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of
