issued out of the Court of common pleas in the said District of Greenville & - tested the day of in the year of our
Thousand eight hundred and seventeen at the suit of Absalom
Thompson against the administrators of Clayborn Johnson
Deceased to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods & Chattles,
Lands & tenements of Clayborn Johnson Deceased to levy the sum
of one thousand Dollars - damages and cost I have seized
& taken of the lands & tenements of the said Clayborn Johnson
Deceased all that certain piece, parcel & tract of land, containing
seventy five acres of land more or less situate and being in
the said District of Greenville on Morgans creek adjacent of
Tyger River Beginning on a Poplar thence along William
Wood line a south course to a Red oak corner thence along
Thomas Bensons line an east course to the mouth of Morgans
Creek thence up Morgans Creek to the Beginning corner
Whereas the said premises, with their appurtenances, since
the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before
mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue and
Purchased by Absalom Thompson of the District of Greenville for
the sum of one hundred & fifty Dollars that part a sum
Being the highest sum that was bid for the same
Ye, that I the said Thompson Payne Sheriff of aforesaid,
by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed
& delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute in such
case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum
of one hundred & fifty Dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be
paid by the said Absalom Thompson the receipt & payment
whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, Bargained and
sold, & by these presents do grant, Bargain sell unto the said
Absalom Thompson his heirs & assigns for ever, the said piece
and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, & all the estate, rights,
title & interest, which the said Clayborn Johnson did in his life
time of right had of, in and unto the same. To have and to
hold the said piece, parcel, and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto
the said Absalom Thompson his heirs, and assigns forever, as fully and
absolutely as I the said Tho^s Payne as Sheriff aforesaid might, could or
ought to grant, bargain & sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid
