Know all men by these presents that I John Strawhorn for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland (Merchant) of the district of Greenville & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs & assigns forever all that part or parcel of land where I John Strawhorn now lives containing fifty acres more or less being a part of a tract sold by Solomon Langston to Pink Hawkins Ist & from him conveyed to me, the part now to be conveyed begins on a Turkey Oak on Sand Nelys spring branch thence along a blased line to a hickory thence up a branch to an ash thence up a small branch to Geo McClanahan or Archers line thence along the line of McClanahan or Archers line to a chestnut, thence along Sand Nelys line to a pine stump, thence along said Nelys line to a Willow, on Sand Nelys spring branch, thence down the branch to the beginning. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenance. To have & to hold all and singular the said premises here mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs & assigns forever. & I the said John Strawhorn do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & admors & every of them to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
