provided always upon the conditions following (to wit.) that if
the said James Young his heirs, executors adm^r shall well & truly pay
or cause to be paid to the said John McCollister or his certain attorney
exec^r adm^r or assigns the sum of one hundred dollars according to
two notes of hand given by James Young to the said John McCollister
first note of fifty dollars dated December the 13th day in the year 1820.
and to be paid the 25th day of December in the year 1822, the other
note of fifty dollars, and dated the same of the first, to be paid
the 25th day of December in the year 1822. and upon failure of the said
James Young not paying the sum of the said notes then & in that
case the said John McCollister may sell the above mortgaged land
to pay the said debt but if the said James Young his heirs, exec^r
adm^r or any of them pay the sum of the said notes that then &
from this instrument of writing & every thing therein contained
to be null and void otherwise to stand & remain in full
