To all whom these presents shall come, I Am W Crowder Sheriff of Sumville district, and state aforesaid, send greeting, Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of the court of common Pleas held for the district of Sumville tated the first Monday after the fourth Monday in October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty at the suit of Abiell Daniel against Tho Underwood to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods & chattles, lands & tenements, of Tho Underwood, to levy the sum of three hundred & thirty six dollars & ninety six cents, damages & costs, I have seized and taken of the lands, ~~of the lands~~ and tenements of the said Thomas Underwood all that certain piece, parcel & tract of land, containing one hundred & eighty acres situate & being in the district of Sumville and State aforesaid, on the middle
