Holcomb of Kershaw district, South Carolina, have granted, bargained, sold & released & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Geo. W. Holcomb a plantation or tract of land lying and being in Kershaw district on the waters of Gum Creek water of South Carolina river. Beginning at a poplar & running thence N 60 W 16 ch to a stake 3 x thence N 85 W 16 ch and fifty links to a chestnut thence S 32 W 25 ch & 30 links to a stake 3 x thence S 58 E 30 ch to a stake 3 x thence N 32 E 20 ch to a red oak 3 x thence a strait course to the beginning containing by estimation eighty acres to the same more or less if being part of a tract granted to Richd. Brasel by patent bearing date July the 1st 1793. Singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Geo. W. Holcomb his heirs & assigns forever defend all & singular the said I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Exors & admors do warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said George W. Holcomb his heirs & assigns against myself, my heirs, & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th day of Feb in the year of our Lord 1821. Signed, Sealed & delivered in presence of us.
