 Wood of Greenville district & State aforesaid for and in consideration of  
 the Just sum of three hundred & thirty dollars to me in hand paid  
 by John Petty Pool of the district & State aforesaid have bargained  
 sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release un-  
 to the said John Petty Pool all that tract or parcel of land cont-  
 -aining one hundred & ten acres be the same more or less beginning  
 on a red oak corner S<sup>o</sup> side of Beaverdam Creek running N<sup>o</sup> 63 East  
 to the Creek thence down the meanders of S<sup>o</sup> Creek to the mouth of  
 a branch to a white wood corner thence up S<sup>o</sup> branch to a maple  
 corner thence S<sup>o</sup> 30.90 to a light wood stake 3x thence S<sup>o</sup> 63 N<sup>o</sup> to a  
 Spanish oak thence N<sup>o</sup> 27 W<sup>o</sup> to the beginning. Together with all  
 & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the  
 said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have & to  
 hold all & singular premises before mentioned unto the said John  
 P. Pool his heirs executors or any of them to warrant & forever def-  
 -end all & singularly the said premises unto the said John P.  
 Pool his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every  
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any  
 part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 30<sup>th</sup> day 1808.

 in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Triplett Cannaday, of the state and district afo<sup>r</sup>  
 lying on both sides little aurbins Creek beginning on a black oak dead  
 near George Lyons fence running thence S. 80 E. 66.50 to post oak thence N 38 18  
 to stake 3x thence N 10. 63 to stake on Abner Jones line thence S. 20 N. 30 E. to the  
 beginning which includes the land sold & conveyed be the same more or  
 less the land conveyed was originally granted to William Steel binding on  
 John Cannaday Edward Howard George Lyons & Abner Jones - Together with  
 all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances there  
 unto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto  
 unto the only proper use & behoof of him the s<sup>d</sup> Triplett Cannaday
