-teenth year of the independence of the United
States of America between Lunford Hudson of Greenville
County State of South Carolina of the one part and
Pleasant Hudson of the said county and State of the
said of the other part Witnesseth for and in consider-
ation of the sum of Five pounds Sterling Lawful
money of said State in hand paid by Pleasant Hud-
-son hath bargained and sold and by these presents
doth bargain sell and make over unto the said plea-
sant Hudson a certain plantation or tract of land
containing one hundred acres lying in Greenville
County on Roctey Creek Enore River and hath such
boundaries where as, it beginning on a black oak
Station on S.E. line from thence to red oak corner
from thence S 25 to stake corner from thence
N 75 W to a stake corner thence N 13 to a heavy, oak
corner from thence W. 16. to stake corner from
thence N 10. W to a heavy corner from thence
a straight line to the beginning, it being a part
of a tract of land containing nine hundred
and eighty three acres granted unto Lun-
Hudson from under the hand of his Excel-
lency Charles Pinckney Esqr. bearing date the
seventh day of Novr one thousand seven
hundred and ninety one recorded in March
E. N. R. page 77. he hath been let bargained
