Greenville Dist. } I William Bates of the District of
Greenville and State aforesaid so for and in consideration
of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to me paid by John
Bates Junr of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid
Have granted bargained and sold & released unto the ^{do}
John Bates one tract or lot of land situate lying ^{being} in the
District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters
of the north fork of Saluda River bounded as follows
To wit beginning at the forks of the branch that
Runs in to the branch called the mill branch, thence
Running up the branch that heads near the Widow Gill's
old fields bounded on lands belonging to John & William
Bates containing fifty acres more or less it being
Part of tract of land that was original granted to
John Bool on the sixth day of Feber 1786 conveyed
By Jo Bull to Bayless Earle to John Bates Junr. conveyed
From John Bates senr to William Bates together with
all & singular the rights members hereditaments and
appurtenances to the ^{do} premises he longing or in any
wise incident or appurtenance to have & to hold
all and singular the premises he fore mentioned
The ^{do} John Bates Junr his heirs Executors Administrators
For ever & I do hear by him self my self my heirs
Executors and Administrators to warrant & defend
All and singular the ^{do} premises unto the ^{do} John Bates
His heirs & assigns a gainst my self & my heirs a gainst
Every other person whoe so ever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof in witness where of
I have unto set my hand & seal this 15 sept in the year of
our lord one thousand Eight hundred & twenty one & in
the forty fifth of the independance of the united States of a
merica signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
