that I Thomas G. Walker are held & firmly
bound unto Vincent Wilson and William
Wilson in the Just & full sum of ~~one thousand~~
thousand dollars In testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 29 day
July 1822. The Condition of the above oblig-
ation is such that where as Tho. G. Walker
has this day sold and released unto Vincent Wilson
and William Wilson a certain tract of Land contain-
ing in the whole tract three hundred & thirty
acres more or less, first one hundred acres was and
is liand to David Mendenly he fore the sale
of the balance two hundred and thirty acres
more or less the notes for the payment of this
tract now sold to the said Vincent & William
Wilson was executed 9th July 1822 the obligate-
our for the payment of said money is drawn for
the payment of one hundred dollars each
annually the first payment 1st Jan'y 1823 - 2nd 1824
3rd 1825 4th 1826 5th 1827 6th 1828. which is six hundred
dollars the Condition now in case the said
Thomas G. Walker shall execute good & lawful
titles for said Land to said Vincent & William
Wilson binding himself his heirs & assigns to forever
warrant and defend the same to said Vincent &
William Wilson a gainst my self my heirs &
assigns and a gainst all and every person or
persons what so ever ever claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof then this obligation
to be void otherwise to remain in full & virtue
agst. said Walker his heirs & assigns 9th July 1822.
