Know all men by these presents that I
Miles Southern of Greenville District and State aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars to me paid by Gipson Southern Senr of the
same place do bargain sell unto the said Gipson Southern
Southern his heirs and assigns One bay mare saddle and
bridle, two sows & pigs Two feather beds and furniture &
two chests and also all my house hold and kitchen furniture
belonging to me and all my plantation tools to have
hold and enjoy unto the said Gipson Southern
Senr his heirs assigns Executors Administrators and I
do forever warrant and defend my self my heirs
and assigns Executors Administrators from every other
person claiming or to claim the same or any part
there of in witness whereof I have unto set my hand
and seal this 29 March 1822 in the presence
