Know all men by these presents, that I William Ashmore of Greenville District and State aforesaid have for the consideration of the sum of seven hundred and dollar bargained and sold unto David Taylor Curator of the District & State aforesaid, all that tract parcel or plantation of land whereon I now live lying on the East side of Rudy River and containing by estimation three hundred and thirty five acres or the same more or less and bounded as follows Vizt. - beginning on a Red oak corner on Jordan Moor land and running N 60 E 15.50 to a stake on William Richardsons line thence S 57 E 45 to Rocky creek thence down the creek on Ezekiel Hendersons land to a gum corner on the west bank of the creek thence a cross the creek running S 21 E to said Stetline thence S 49. W 8 to a white oak corner on the north bank of said creek thence down the meanders of the creek to its mouth in Rudy River thence up the river with the water to a poplar on John Dabiss' land thence north 4 chains to a hickory on Dacuss land thence on D. land a straight line to a hickory near the waggon Road. thence on to the beginning Red Oak corner which includes the whole land to be conveyed part of which was originally granted to Lewis Duvall by Monllantre on the 4th September 1786. the other granted by the same to the same on the 3rd May 1786 - including three hundred and thirty five acres or the same more or less. Together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the said William Ashmore doth here by bind him self his heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend the above described premises with all and singular the appurtenances and hereunto by these presents
