my right, interest title and estate therein or thereto  
in as full and ample a manner as the same  
can be conveyed; To have and hold all  
and singular the premises within before  
mentioned and ascertained to the said  
the said Lawrence <sup>Brock</sup> and Henry Brock their  
heirs and assigns forever; and I do here by  
bind myself my heirs Executor and administra-  
-ator to warrant and for ever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said Lawrence  
Brock and Henry Brock their heirs & assigns  
against me and my heirs & those claiming  
under me and them but against no other  
person who ~~is~~ <sup>shall</sup> touch my hand and  
seal this ninth day of August Eighteen hun-  
-dred and seven ty two and in the forty sixth  
year of American independence.
