S^t 20 E. 24. 5 to a sander wood on the north bank
of S^d Reedy fork thence drawn S^d brak with the
meanders thence to a sweet gum on said side of
said brak thence a straight line to the begining corner
including one hundred and forty seven acres, more
or less. Together with all and singular the rights -
members hereditaments & appurtenances there
unto belonging or in any wise incident or appertain
ing thereto & I do hereby bind my self, my
heirs Executors administrators or assigns to war
rant & forever defend all and singular the
