Know all men by these presents that I Alexander
Drewal of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of the sum of fifty dollars
to me paid by John Croft of the district and State
afore said have granted bargained and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said John Croft Fifty acres of land more or
less lying on the south side of Rudy River being
part of a tract of originally granted to Samuel
Bottling and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie
on the fourth day of September one thousand seven
hundred and eighty six. the said Fifty acres of
land more or less is laid out unto the said John Croft
as follows beginning on a post oak on a line Robins land
running along the said Robins line to a post oak corner
on the original line, thence running a long a conditional
line to a stake corner on the original line thence along
the original line to the beginning including fifty
acres of land more or less. Together with all and
singular the rights, members hereditaments to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing to have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said John
Croft his heirs and assigns for ever and I do here
by state bind my self my heirs Executors and administrat-
ors, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
the said Fifty acres of land more or less with the prem-
ises unto the said John Croft his heirs and
