South Carolina. To all to whom these presents shall come  
I Thomas Payne Sheriff of Gunnville District and state  
aforesaid, in a writing; where as, by virtue of an order issued  
out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for said district  
tested the second day of November in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and fifteen at the suit  
of Robert Alexander one of the heirs of James Seabourn  
Deceased, against Mary Seabourn the widow, by a writ  
of partition which order directed that I should on the first  
Monday in January then next ensuing after having giving  
lawful notice there of, proceed to sell the lands of James  
Seabourn Deceased, agreeable to the Return of the Commissioners  
in convenient tracts, lots or Plantations, upon a credit of  
Twelve months and that the moneys arising from  
said sales be divided between the parties entitled pursuant  
to the directions of the act of assembly in obedience to the said  
order. I have seized and taken of the lands of the said  
James Seabourn a tract of three hundred and eleven acres  
more or less distinguished as lot No. 6 situated in Gunnville District  
on both sides of Stony Creek waters of Reddy River, beginning  
at a Black Oak Running thence S. 54 E. 80 to a
