State of South Carolina } Know all men by these presents  
Gunnville District } that I James Nicoll of the State  
and District aforesaid in consideration of two hundred  
dollars to me in hand paid by William Bradley of the  
State & district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and  
released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the sd William Bradley, all that plantation or tracts  
of land whereon <sup>sd Bradley</sup> he now lives containing one hundred acres  
more or less situate in the district on the waters of Ellush  
Creek bounded as follows viz Beginning on a post  
Oak in John Nicoll Sr. original lines with said  
Northwardly to Callaways corner near the head  
of a branch thence with said Callaways line
