dollars to me paid by John Gowen of said
District have granted bargained, sold & releas-
-ed and by these presents do grant bargain
sell & release unto the said John Gowen a certain
plantation or Tract of Land laying & being
in Greenville District & State aforesaid on the north side
of the Middle fork of Saluda River the planta-
-tion whereon the said Henry Woolf now lives -
being part of a Tract of Land granted
