do grant, bargain sell, and release unto
the said Daniel Rector a certain Tract
of Land, lying and being in the District
aforesaid on the Branches of Mountain Creek
waters of Enoree River Containing two hundred
and ninety three acres being part of a Tract
of Land originally granted to Forrest Hudson
deceased, beginning at a Black Oak corner
thence N 17 E 28 to a Hickory 3 + thence 13 w 43 to a
Poplar 3 + thence meandering with a Branch
to a S. Gum 3 + thence with a another Branch
to a pine Stump 3 + thence S 25 W 32 to a Bee
Tree 3 + thence S 2. W. 23 to a Stake 3 + thence E 84.50
to the beginning corner, Together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Daniel
Rector, his heirs and assigns forever and I
do here by bind my self my heirs Executors
and Administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Daniel Rector his heirs and
assigns against my self and my heirs and
against every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part
there of, Witness my hand and seal this 18 day
of December in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twenty one
