 Bruton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 and the said William B. Benson & Horton Benson  
 have granted bargained and sold unto the sd.  
 Soab Bruton part of a Tract of Land on morose  
 Creek of Enore River originally granted unto  
 Nathaniel Pury by his Excellency William Moultrie  
 the fourth of July 1785. beginning at a Stake near  
 the head of a branch on the old line. Running  
 thence No. 80. E 7 Chn. to a post oak. thence S 40 E 37  
 70 to a Spanish Oak thence S 10 W 20. 10. to a post  
 oak thence S 60 W 12. to a post oak. thence with  
 said line to the Fox Branch thence with said  
 branch to the mouth of said branch (viz) to  
 to morose Creek. thence up the meanders of said  
 Creek to front line on said Creek from thence  
 with said line to the beginning. borne on said State  
 the number of acres or less on the said William  
 B. Benson & Horton Benson. will warrant &  
 for ever defend the above mentioned land  
 unto the said Soab Bruton his heirs & assigns and  
 clear from us our heirs Executors & admors. & from  
 all and every person or persons, whomsoever laying  
 any just right or legal claim to the same In  
 Witness whereof we have hereunto set our  
 hands & seals this 24<sup>th</sup> day December 1802 Signed
