



by Moses Bates of the State and district aforesaid  
the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged have  
granted regained and sold and released unto the said  
Moses Bates a piece or parcel of land containing twenty  
Acres more or less on the waters of Enore adjoining a peo-  
=ce of Land conveyed from Thomas Fisher to Moses Bates  
beginning on a maple a conditional corner made betw-  
=en Thomas Fisher and Enoch Cooksey Running up  
the meanders of said Branch to a gum corner then  
conditional South Eastward until it intersects with  
Moses Bates line thence with said line to the beginning

To have and to hold all and singular the Rights members  
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
to have and to hold all and singular the said premises be-  
fore mentioned unto the said Moses Bates his heirs and assigns  
=nd forever I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors administrators  
to warrant and forever defend the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Moses Bates his heirs and assigns against my self  
my heirs and against all and every other person lawfully el-  
=aiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness  
whereof I have set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of  
April in the year one thousand eight hundred and ten signed  
Sealed and delivered in presence of

1810.
