Know all men by these presents that I David Fowler of Granville District and State aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Dyer of the District and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and Released unto the said Samuel Dyer a plantation or tract of Land Lying and being situate in the District and State aforesaid on Maple creek wat = us. of Puddy River, the land to be conveyed begins on R<sup>o</sup> 3x runs on Roach's line corners. to R<sup>o</sup> 3x on sea bours. line then East to a stake then North to pine st then to the beginning including one hundred acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises, beloning or in any wise Incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises be fore mentioned unto the said Samuel Dyer his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind Myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises be fore mentioned unto the said Samuel Dyer his heirs or assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person wh omsoever law fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness where of I have here = unto set my hand and seal this second day of April 1811.
