 Philamon Huff John Easter and Henry Paris  
 trustees for the use of the said Society for the  
 purpose before mentioned. And I do here by  
 warrant and defend the said premises unto the  
 said James Douthett, Isaac Elrod Philamon Huff  
 John Easter and Henry Paris and their successors  
 in office for ever for the use before mentioned  
 against myself and my heirs and against every  
 other person or persons whomsoever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part
