 Drury Morris deceased I have released and conveyed
 and by these presents do convey and release unto
 the said William Morris all my interest in
 that part of the above mentioned premises as
 is described in the following boundaries. -
 Beginning on a stout Gum 3x on a branch
 (near Wm Morris still house) thence running
 N 22 W 370 to a pine 3x thence S 10 W 35 to a
 Hickory 3x thence S 60 W 20 50 to a stake 3x
 thence S 35 E 65 to a stake 3x thence
