Edwards of Greenville District in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars  
to me paid by Robert Murrell of the State of the State  
North Carolina, Lincoln District have granted & sold  
= and sold and released, and by these presents do  
Grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Robert Murrell all that plantation or tract of  
Land containing one hundred and forty five acres  
be the same more or less situate lying and being  
in Greenville District in the State aforesaid at the  
head of a branch of Shoal creek fork of  
Clear creek of South Tyger River and bounded  
as follows beginning on a hickory corner marked  
37 running from thence S 60 W 54 ch. to a red oak  
corner marked 37 thence S 0. 11 ch. 50 links to a  
post oak corner marked 37 thence N 0. 60. W 31.  
Ch. 50. links to a red oak corner marked 37 thence  
N 0. 80. E 31 ch. 50. links to a chestnut corner marked 37  
thence South 80. E 61. ch. to the Beginning hickory corner  
marked as aforesaid. being part of a tract of  
Land originally granted to to Enoch Benson, and  
lying on both sides of the Buncomb Road  
Together with all and singular the rights members  
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to  
Have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned, unto the said Robert Murrell  
his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by bind  
my self my heirs executors and administrators to  
warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said Robert Murrell  
his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs  
and against every every person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof witness my hand and seal the twelfth  
Sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and twenty two and  
in the forty sixth year of the American Independence
