or parcel of Land, situated in the district of Greenville  
on the waters of Mill Creek being part of a tract of  
Land, granted to Samuel McClure by patent bear-  
ing date 4 day February 1793, beginning at a stake near  
Andrew Thompsons Corner, running thence S. 40. E. 23. 50. to  
a hickory thence South 27. N. 5. to a post oak, thence  
N. 45. W. 19. to a black gum, Barretts, Corner thence N. 10.  
W. 20. 50 to a red Oak, Barretts, Corner, thence N. 10.
