South Carolina Know all men by these
Greenville District Presents that I Henry Prince
of the District and State aforesaid, for the love good
will and affection which I have and bear unto my
Daughter Mary Turner of the same State and District
wife of Joseph Turner have given granted made
over and confirmed, and by these presents do freely
give grant make over confirm and deliver unto the
said Mary Turner to her only use benefit and be-
-hoof and to the natural heirs of her body forever in
the following manner, & not otherwise, to wit, one negro
girl named Fran now about six years old, and the future
increase of the said negro girl, to remain continue & be in the
power and possession of the said Mary Turner, during her
natural life; and at her death the said Negro girl and
her future increase to be equally divided between the
-children of the said Mary Turner, then living, hereby war-
-ranteeing & confirming the said negro girl unto the said Ma-
-ry Turner, and her heirs forever - In witness whereof
I have hereunto signed my name and affixed my seal
this seventeenth day of September A.D. 1844.
