 Know all men by these presents that Thomas Dyer of  
 the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of  
 two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Nathan Berry  
 of the State and District aforesaid, have granted bargained  
 and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain  
 sell and unto the said Nathan Berry a plantation or tra  
 ct of Land that was originally granted to John Saffely  
 in September 1788. Recorded in grant book page 486 viz  
 the S.W part the N.E part was originally granted to John  
 Linderman on the 28 of April 1794. Recorded in grant  
 Book K. No. 5 page 236. then conveyed from said Saffely  
 and Linderman on through different hands down  
 to William Mayhall, then from said Mayhall to Thomas  
 Dyer now from said Dyer to said Berry beginning on  
 a poplar on the south side of Lindermans Creek thence running  
 N 32 W 12 Chain to a post oak thence S 39 W 48 Chain  
 to a hick oak thence S 86 E 19.25 Chain to a maple thence  
 N 50 E 40 Chain to a pine thence N 35 W 12 Chain to a  
 Maple on the side of a branch thence down said  
 branch to the mouth to a stake in the creek thence  
 up said creek to the beginning including one hundred  
 and five acres be it the same more or less situate in  
 said State and District lying on the waters of Lindermans  
 back water of Rudy River Together with all and  
 singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances to the said premises or in any wise in  
 debt or appurtenant to have and to hold all and sing  
 gular premises here fore mentioned unto the said Nathan
