Know all men by these presents that I Walker Brock of the district and state aforesaid for and in consideration of five hundred dollars paid by Alexander Vickers of the district & state aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Vickers one certain lot of Land. Situate lying and being in the village of Pleasantburgh at Greenville Court House in the state of South Carolina known and distinguished in the plan or Chart of said Village by the number twenty two (22) Containing one hundred and forty feet front on main street and one hundred and seventeen and a half feet on the piece that he gave Mrs. Wickliff beginning at a State Corner on the West side of main street running thence North 74 1/2 degrees West 117 1/2 feet to a stake thence South 15 1/2 degrees West 140 feet to a stake thence South 74 1/2 degrees East one hundred and seventeen and a half feet to a stake on the side of main street thence North 15 1/2 degrees East one hundred and forty feet along main street to the beginning one half acre be the same more or less.

Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned. The hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander Vickers his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander Vickers his heirs and assigns ~~in and against~~ ~~any person or persons~~ lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 29 day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred twenty one and in the forty sixth year of the independence of the United States of America in the presence of
