I know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Griffith  
of Hall County State of Georgia for an consideration of the  
sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Duvieux  
Yeargin of Grenville District and State of South Carolina I have  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do  
grant bargain and sell unto the said Duvieux Yeargin a p-  
plantation or tract of Land lying and being situate in the Distri-  
ct and State aforesaid on both sides of Gilders Creek waters of  
Crown River the Land to be conveyed was granted to the said  
Griffith by patent bearing date the seventh of October 1822 and  
begins at pine stump 3x. am. thence S. 80. W. 43 chs. to P. 3. thence  
N. 10 E. 47. ch B. 3x thence S. 61. E. 15. 50. W. thence thence down with  
the meanders of the Creek to Stake 3x. thence E. 10. ch to maple on
