This <sup>96</sup> indenture made this 13<sup>th</sup> of January 1824 between Aaron Templeton  
man of South Carolina Spartanburgh district of the one part  
and Charles Gasnell of Greenville District and State of South Carolina  
of the other witnesseth that the said Aaron Templeton for a  
consideration of ten dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof  
he doth acknowledge he hath given granted bargained and  
sold unto Charles Gasnell a certain tract or plantation lying  
in the same State and Greenville district joining of the Glassey Rock  
beginning at a post oak running north 75 E. 8 to a white oak S.  
36 E to hickory North 76 E 10 to white oak S. 45 E 10 to a chestnut N. 45  
E 4 to a chestnut Glassey Rock thence Bensons line to the beginning  
containing twenty acres more or less together with all wood waters mines  
minerals hereditaments and appurtenances to the sd Charles Gasnell his  
heirs and assigns forever he yielding and paying such sum or sums  
of money as our general assembly may appoint and the sd Aaron Templeton  
and the premises I do Templeton doth warrant and defend to land  
from me and my heirs and any other person whereby the aforesaid land  
may be damaged in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal  
the day and date above mentioned in presence of  
John Bellw. James Howard. Aaron <sup>his mark</sup> Templeton.
