Know all men by these presents that I John Clark of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum fifty dollars to me in hand paid by John Peace Jr of the district and state aforesaid Have granted bargained and sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Peace a plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the dist and state aforesaid on both sides of Naugahook Creek waters of No. Pacolet River Bounded on all sides by vacant land and having such shapes and marks as are laid down in the plat and surveyed for said John Clark the 30th November 1814 and granted by His excellency Joseph Aston Governor &c the fifth day of December 1814 with all and every particular containing one hundred and thirty four Acres. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments to the said premises, belaning or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John Peace and his heirs by bind my self my heirs Executors admors to warrant and forever defend unto the said John Peace him his heirs and assigns forever against my self my heirs & against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of November 1816. Signed and acknowledged in presence of us.
