

Meriman Burnes directed to all and singular the Sheriffs of said State which Execution was duly entered in the Sheriffs office of said District the 5 of December 1812. the said John Wood did enter upon & seize under the said execution a certain tract or parcel of land herein after more particularly described and after notice of the intended sale of said Land did on the seventh day of June 1813 openly publicly & fairly according to the custom of Vandalia expose subject nevertheless to all legal incumbrances whatsoever the same to sale to the highest bidder at Greenville Court House in the district aforesaid and the said Land being so exposed was struck off to the said Robert Grur for the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars he being the highest & last bidder for the same Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Wood as Sheriff of the District aforesaid for & in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert Grur the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Robert Grur all that plantation or tract of land containing three hundred & sixty Acres more or less lying & being in the district aforesaid on the waters of Enore River joining the tract belonging to Warner & Burnes at the Cross Road & known by the name of John Wheelers old place divided from said Wheelers to Meriman Burnes with all and singular the Rights members appurtenances to the said premises belonging incident or in any wise appertaining and all the Rights title claims demands or demands the said Burnes had in said Land at the time of the State To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land as above described unto the said Robert Grur his heirs & assigns forever subject never the less as above mentioned In witness whereof of the said John Wood Sheriff aforesaid have here unto set my hand & seal this day and year first above written.
