 consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid have
 granted, bargained, sold and released and do by these presents do
 grant bargain, sell and release unto Thomas Edwards of
 of the district and State aforesaid all that plantation tract or
 parcel, of Land situate lying and being within the district
 and State aforesaid on the Cane brake branch of Enoree River
 beginning at a stake thence No. 20. E. 60 ch to a P.O. 3x. thence
 along a conditional line to a white Oak corner on the said
 Cane brake branch thence a long the said branch upward
 to a poplar corner thence S. 72. 25. to the beginning contain-
 -ing fifty acres more or less being the same land conveyed to
 me by William Brown and part of a tract originally
 granted to one Kemp Together with all and singular
 the Rights members hereafterments and appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
 taining To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned to the said Thomas Edwards his heirs and afi-
 -gers forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administ-
 -rators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Thomas Edwards his heirs and afigers against
 myself and my heirs and against every other person lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my
 hand and seal this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty and in the forty fifth year
 of American Independence
