Know all men by these presents that I John Shoemaker of  
the State & district aforesaid for and in consideration of the  
sum of two hundred dollars to me paid in hand by  
John Gilbert of State & district aforesaid have this day bargained  
and sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said John Gilbert a certain tract or parcel  
of land containing one hundred Acres situate in State & district  
aforesaid on waters of Rudy River and bounded as follows  
beginning on a Stake and running S.W. McCleary and Bennett line  
to a Market Road to Gillam line thence N.E. to a Po. corner  
thence on a line of marked trees to Stake corner on the old  
line including that boundary one hundred Acres also one  
other small tract containing fifteen acres beginning on a  
Post oak corner of the above mentioned land and running south  
west 20.49 to a Red Oak corner of the original line thence  
S.W. 60.25 to a B Jack corner of the original thence N.W. 35 to  
a Oak thence a straight line to the beginning corner also a  
nother tract or parcel of Land adjoining the first a bond  
mentioned tract and lying on the West side of the Mail Road  
and bounded by John M. Courtney land, Robin land, and the  
land whereon said Gilbert now lives line marks as follows beginning  
on a post oak and running N. 62 E. 10 to pine, <sup>thence</sup> N. 28 W. to a Po. thence S. 60.  
W. 16 to a stake on the Road thence up the Road to the beginning con-  
taining ten acres more or less together with all and singular  
the premises, a bond mentioned the rights members hereditaments  
and and appurtenance therunto belonging or in any wise  
incident therunto to the said John Gilbert his or assigns for  
ever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs &c to warrant  
and forever defend all & singular the premises, a bond mentioned
