Clark of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John J. Clark all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and eleven acres (more or less) situated in Greenville District lying on Little Horse Creek Beginning on a maple 3x. on said Creek thence S. 140 E 21 up the meanders of a small branch to a stake 3x. Bounding on the said William Wright land north <sup>or the</sup> 1. 25 to a Red oak 3x. S. 65 W. 33. 75 to a stake 3x. N. 5 E 16. 75 to a white oak 3x. Bounding on the said J. J. Clark land.
