 nine and a half dollars to me in hand paid by William Gunn
 of the district and state aforesaid do grant bargain sell, and
 release unto the said William Gunn a certain tract of land
 containing by estimation seventy seven acres a quarter to a
 plat of the same beginning at a Spanish Oak corner and
 running East to the head of a branch which is the Spring
 branch of said Land thence with the meanders of said bran-
 ch to bushy Creek thence up said creek to biglers branch
 thence up said branch to a white oak corner thence
 a quarter to plat to a stone corner and thence to the begin-
 -ing corner which tract of land of seventy seven acres together
