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State of South Carolina Greenville District I know  
 all men by these presents that I William Green of State  
 and district aforesaid for and in consideration of four hun-  
 dred dollars to me in hand paid by Harman Young have  
 bargained and sold all that plantation or tract of land  
 containing by estimation twenty seven acres or more to  
 a plot of the same, beginning at a Spanish oak corner  
 and running East to the head of a branch which is  
 the Spring branch of said land thence with the meanders  
 of said branch to Bushy Creek thence up said creek  
 to big lops branch thence up said branch to a white oak  
 corner thence a quarter to plot to a stone corner thence  
 to the beginning corner which tract of land of twenty  
 seven acres together with all and singular the rights  
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
 said premises, belaning or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining to have and to Hold all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
 said Harman Young his heirs and assigns for ever
