

The State of South Carolina ^{do} know all men by these presents that I Master Tabours of Greenville District have for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by William Gamblill sen of Pendleton District, granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Gamblill his heirs and assigns a small tract of land containing three fourths of an acre more or less situated in Greenville District in the state aforesaid on Saluda River begining on white oak 3x on the bank of the river about one chain below said Gamblill Bridge thence N. 52 E. 18 to a hickory 3x thence N 42 1/2 W. 8.00 to a hickory 3x thence S 52 W. 68 to a pine 3x thence N 42 1/2 W. 68 to a red oak 3x thence N. 68 W. 4.00 to a post oak 3x thence S. 0. 73 to sweet gum 3x on the River thence down the meander of the River to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Gamblill his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Gamblill his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and also against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this the day of March one thousand eight hundred and twenty four and in the forty eighth year of the independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in presence of.
