 W. Crowder Sheriff of Greenville, District, and State of aforesaid,
 Land greeting: where as, by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out
 of the court of common pleas, held for the District tested the second
 Day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred
 and twenty one at the Suit of the Treasurers of the State of South
 Carolina against Adam Carruth to me directed, commanding
 me that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of the said
 Adam Carruth to levy the sum of twenty thousand Dollars dam-
 =ages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the
 said Adam Carruth all that certain piece parcel and tract of land,
 containing four hundred and thirty four acres more or less situate
 and being in the district of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
 Being a tract of land originally granted to the said Adam Carruth
 By Grant bearing date the 20th day of December 1804. Beginning at
