

By the said Abraham Cox Junr one a man named Alexander a bought  
 fifty five or sixty years old the other a woman named Eade a bought  
 fifty or fifty five years old the wife of the said Alexander & also one  
 certain horse cattle Hoop & house hold furniture that belong to the  
 said two Negroes, which negroes & property before mentioned I war-  
 rant & forever defend from my heirs Executors & administrators & assigns  
 & here by bind my heirs Executors & administrators jointly & severally to  
 Warrant & forever defend the same to the said Abraham Cox Junr  
 But it is further understood that I Benj<sup>a</sup> Pollard Junr is to keep & have the Slaves  
 of the said two Negroes during my natural life & also my wife shall  
 have the serving of them during her natural life should she live longer  
 than, me, given under my hand & seal this 12<sup>th</sup> July 1822

 Alexander & his wife, Eade, paper, from year to year & that  
 shall labour & trade for their selves & have all the profits of  
 the same & that they shall have all the property that they  
 have when ever they come into my hands & shall have the  
 use of the same continually & it to be at their disposal  
 At their Deaths or any Time before given under my hand,  
 This 12<sup>th</sup> July 1822

 of Lincoln County and State of North Carolina for and in con-  
 sideration of the sum of seven hundred & forty two Dollars & fifty cents  
 to me in hand paid by Samuel Green Esq. of the District of Greenville &  
 State of South Carolina, Have granted bargained, sold released and  
 By these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
 Samuel Green, a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and  
 And being in the District of Greenville & in the forks of the Ruther-  
 ford & Buncombe Road, leading from the village affo<sup>r</sup> Beginning at a  
 Stake & pointers at the forks of the roads Edward Crafts corner and runs  
 along the Rutherford Road N 4 W 130 poles to a stake in said Road
