 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by Moses Cockrell of State &  
 District above mentioned have granted, Bargained, sold and Released and  
 These presents do grant, Bargain sell and Release unto the said Moses  
 Cockrell, a certain plantation or tract of land containing Four-  
 Hundred acres, be the same more or less situate in the dist're and  
 State above written on a small branch of the Reedy Fork of Reedy River.  
 Being part of two tracts, one originally granted to Alexander Johnson  
 By his Excellency Ben. Gerard in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
 hundred and Eighty five and recorded in the Secretary's office Grant  
 Book cccc page 78 containing 640 acres, The other originally gra-  
 nted to John Pyle by Gov. Pinckney on the third day of March one  
 thousand seven hundred and Eighty eight and recorded in Grant  
 Book 4 V<sup>o</sup> page 191 containing 860 Acres, the said tract of four hun-  
 dred acres, more or less being bounded on the west and south west by  
 David Cotton's land one ~~the~~ south by George Seaborn on the East and  
 South east by Pollard's land on the East by Lee on the north by Isaac  
 Roberts and on the north west & west by Rice and Bobbs land, together  
 with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and ap-  
 pertinances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise inci-  
 ent or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the
