 above described Belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Rev  
 eration and Reversions Remainder and Remanides rents issues and  
 Profits there of and Every part and parcel there of and all the Estate  
 Right title interest Claim and Demands what ever both in Law and  
 Equity of the sd. James Brasher of and to the same premises and  
 of in and Every part and parcel there of to have and to hold the sd.  
 Tract of land above described and all and singular other premises  
 above mentioned with the appertanencies unto the said William Cox Junr.  
 His heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the sd.  
 William Cox Junr. his heirs and assigns forever and lastly the sd. James  
 Brasher for himself his heirs and assigns the sd. tract or parcel of  
 Land and all and singular the premises above mentioned and gra  
 nted with the appertanencies unto the sd. William Cox Junr. and his  
 Heirs from the lawful claim of all persons whatsoever will warra  
 nt and forever defend In witness whereof the sd. James Brasher doth  
 set his hand and seal this day and year first above written sign  
 ed sealed and delivered in the presence of
