The State of South Carolina know all men, by these presents, that I James Cooper of the District of Greenville in the state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars, to me paid by William B. Johnson in the state aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said William B. Johnson all that parcel of land lying and being in the District & State aforesaid being a part of the plantation or tract of land on which the said James Cooper resides, the boundary of the said parcel of land beginning at a corner on Mill Creek now a part of the dividing line between myself the said James Cooper, and the said William B. Johnson, and running south eleven degrees East to Saluda River in a strait line to a corner on the said River thence up Saluda River to the mouth of the said mill Creek to the corner between myself the said James Cooper & the said William B. Johnson and thence up the meanders of the said Creek to the corner above mentioned at which the line commences, the said parcel of land containing forty acres, more or less, having such form and marks as the annexed plan represents, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William B. Johnson his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, myself, my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William B. Johnson his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four and in the forty ninth year of the independence of the United States of America signed, sealed, and delivered in the presence of S.
