

I have bargained sold and released & by these presents do
 bargain grant sell & release unto the said James H. Gilbreath
 all that tract plantation or piece of land supposed to
 contain fifty acres be the same more or less situate on a creek
 known by the name of Mountain Creek & lying altogether
 on the south side of said creek Beginning at a poplar at
 the waggon ford of the above named creek thence up the
 meanders of the said creek to the above named William Chandlers
 line to a white Oak corner thence south to the sd Chandlers
 back line to a stake thence along the sd line to the waggon
 road thence along the said road to the Beginning together
 with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining thereto to have and to hold all
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 sd James H. Gilbreath his heirs or assigns for ever & I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Exors & assigns to warrant & for ever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said James H.
 Gilbreath his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
 & against Every Other person or persons whatsoever lawfully
 claiming the same or to claim the same or any part
 thereof witness my hand and seal the 29 day of September
 in the year of Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
 fifteen signed sealed and delivered in presence
 of Isaac Chandler, James Hooker } William ^{his} Chandler }

 he saw William Chandler sign seal and assis act and deed
 thereto at the same time sworn to before me this 24 day
 of February 1816.
