it being part of a tract purchased Alexander Sloan  
for me by granted to Majors Parsons from him conveyed  
to John Moore deceased from his heirs to Thomas Edward  
as by the records will more fully & at large appear beginning  
on a Post Oak in Stones line thence N. 80 E. 29 ch. to a pine  
thence N. 10 E. at 16 ch and 50 links to a white oak on the  
side of a Branch thence up the main end of the branch to  
a white oak corner thence the same course to a Spanish  
Oak corner near the Road leading to McBooks Shoals  
where the Spinning Factory now is thence to the  
beginning containing ninety eight acres more or less  
To have and to hold all & singular the above men-  
tioned premises unto the said Polly Granger & her heirs  
forever & I do bind myself my heirs & assigns  
& for ever defend the above described premises from
